We have been working to the project "Green EYE" for two years. On the first year we, students of 3A, 3B and 4CL, worked on the module 1 "Am I a Green Citizen" and Module 2 "Similar and different environmental issues around Europe". On the second year we developed Module 3 "Let's Face it" and Module 4 "Making a Green Europe".

During this year we have been involved in the project "Green Eye", that consists of improving our environment at school and in the community. We have worked with our European partners coming from Scotland, the Netherlands, Germany and Turkey.

During our Conference in Catania we did a lot of activities and participated in five workshops: in "The Green EYE Journal workshop" we edited and published the magazine reporting any news related to the Conference; then in the "Treasure

After our conference held in Catania we guys feel more motivated in doing the project: we started respecting our school environment, doing the separated recycling with paper and plastic and now we encourage people in doing that, in the same time we improved the quality of our life working together, developing our teamwork thanks to the activities we did in the workshops.
